For the more leisurely, we suggest a visit to Cuil Bay. Alternatively, why not plan a visit to the Islands

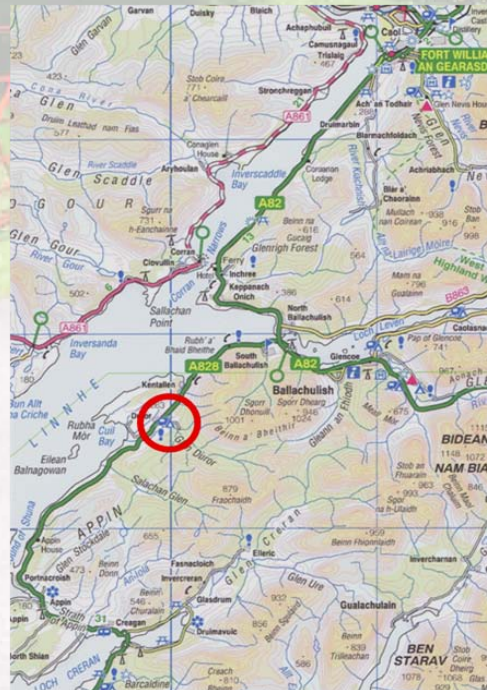
## How to find us:
